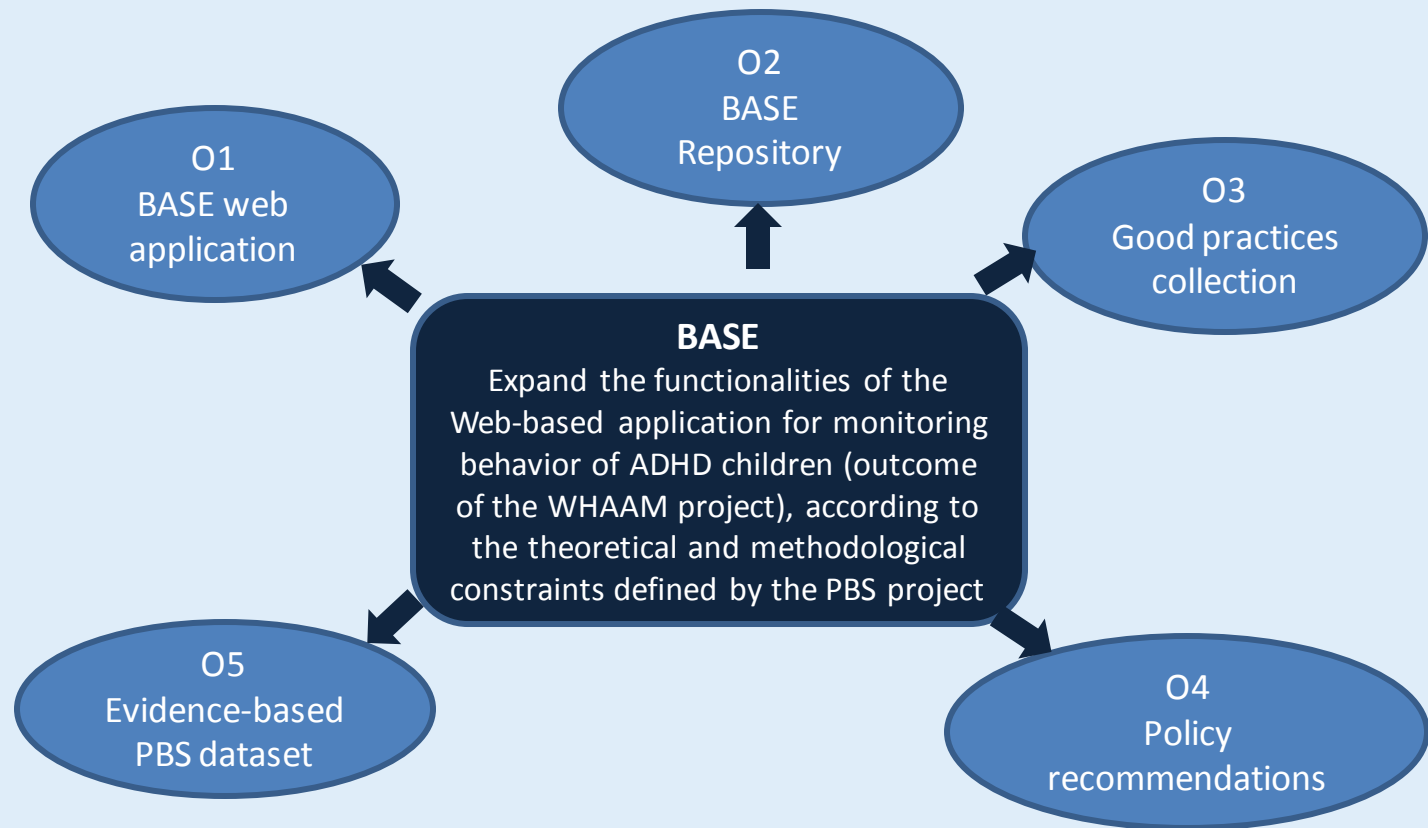

## BASE application

1. Define an evaluation grid as a common framework guiding the gathering of the good practices by partners;

2. The evaluation grid will be released online to encourage the collection of new experiences by people outside the partnership;

3. Partners will identify at least 2- 3 local experiences in the countries;

4. Partners will contact the school leaders (or teachers delegated by them) to interview them about the identified good practice;

5. **The good practices will be published online.**

## A first proposal

### a. Delphi panel in the area of implementing PBS strategies at school

#### Online Round 1

- The first web-based questionnaire includes criteria identified for the evaluation of good practices related to the implementation of PBS strategies at school
- Experts are asked to judge how relevant each item is in assessing PBS interventions using a scale of 1 (not relevant at all) to 9 (highly relevant)
- Experts are able to suggest additional criteria
- The relevance of each item is determined by the median score achieved

## A first proposal

### a. Delphi panel in the area of implementing PBS strategies at school

#### Online Round 2

- The items on which experts had agreed as being relevant (7-9 score) in the first round are presented for rating on a priority scale from 1= lowest priority to 9= highest priority. The higher the value the participant chose, the more priority is attaching the item to assess interventions based on PBS

## A first proposal

### a. Delphi panel in the area of implementing PBS strategies at school

#### Face to face

- A trained facilitator conduct discussions following a structured interview in face to face meetings.
- These group discussions aim to evaluate the relative importance of the criteria identified in previous stages and clarify conditions for the their use or implementation.
